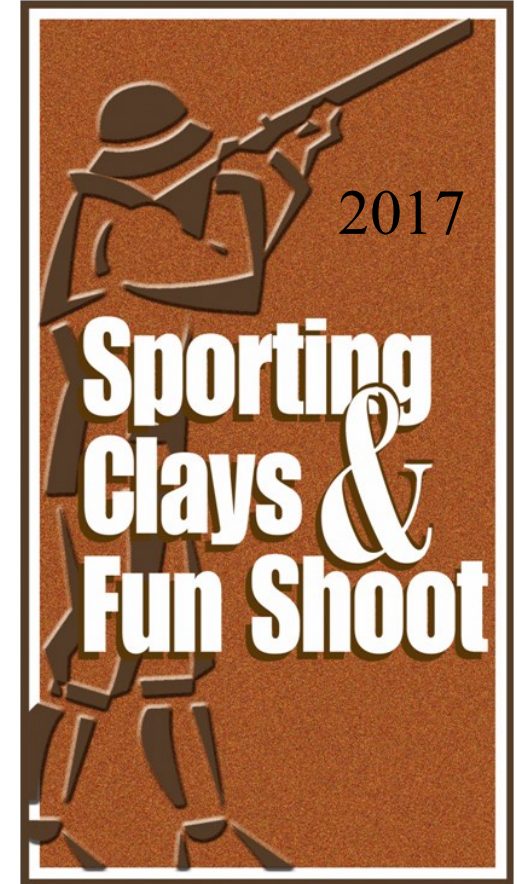

Sporting Clays Shoot

On Saturday, March 4th, the Alabama-Florida Council, Boy Scouts of America will host the 18th Annual Sporting Clays and Fun Shoot at Camp Alaflor in New Brockton, Alabama. As America's fastest growing shooting sport, sporting clays has been called "golf with a gun." Competitors move from station to station through the Boy Scout Camp along a challenging course designed and managed by a leader in the industry, Howell Shooting Supplies. At each of the 12 stations, targets are thrown mimicking hunting presentations. A shooter may encounter flushing "quail", high overhead "dove," bounding "rabbits," or the challenging "springing teal" (straight up).
