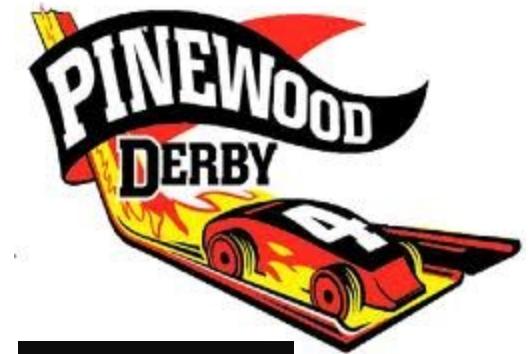

- ◆ Visit their neighbors

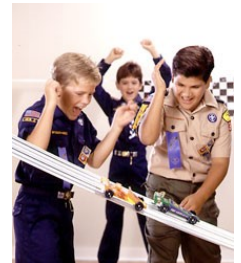

Community Open Race

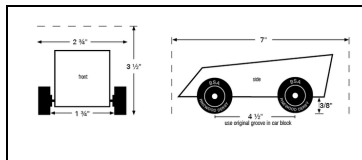
