Butter and Egg

Friday 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm	Arrive. Set up camp. Pavilion access with 2 bathrooms, picnic tables, serving bar, 3-part sink, electricity, fire pit with starter firewood, 2 charcoal grills. 2 Additional restrooms, with outdoor access, are located at the Activity Center.	
Overnight	At campsite with adult supervision provided by troops.	
Saturday 9:00 am – 12:00	Boy Scouts facilitated activities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4-Zip Line course • Climbing Wall and Leap of Faith • Canoeing and Pedal Boating at Lake • Team Competitions at Woodland Encounter Course (Scout groups will be assigned a designated time for this activity) 	
12:00 – 1:30 pm	Lunch at campsite. Concession stand in Activity Center open.	
1:30 – 3:00	Optional add-on for Boy Scouts: Tree Adventure High Ropes Challenge Course (Participants must have ziplined earlier).	Optional fee: \$10.00 per person
1:30 - 3:00	Facilitated Team Competitions for all scouts. (Relays, team challenges, etc.)	
3:00 pm – dark	Scout-led activity. Adult supervision provided by scout leaders/volunteers. Shared, Open Recreation venues available with equipment: GaGa, human foosball, sand volleyball, 9-square in the air, mini golf, kick and wiffle-ball.	
Sunday Until 10:30 am	Open Recreation areas remain available, along with fishing access at lake. Pack up, clean up, Depart.

Waiver Completion and Submission

Ensure that each participant submits a completed, **on-line waiver**. Parents of youth under age 18 must complete waivers for minors, and adults must complete their own waiver. Please share this link with your group members: <http://www.butterandeggadventures.com/waiver> and ask participants to select **your Custom Group Event (AL-FL Boy Scout Council Camporee)** from the drop down menu, which is in chronological order. Please contact us, a few days in advance of your event, if you would like a list of all participants who have successfully completed the on-line waiver. Adults may also sign on-line waivers upon arrival to your event; however, *advance submission of waivers will reduce waiting time once your group arrives*. **NOTE:** Waivers are electronic, do not attempt to print waivers from computer in order to bring to the event.

Recreation and Teambuilding Activity

- Aerial Recreation and Teambuilding: Wear closed-toe shoes or flat, sturdy sandals with heel strap (do not wear flip flops). No restrictions on activity due to injuries to or disabling conditions of limbs, hands, feet, spine, neck, head, or pregnancy.
- **Aerial Recreation: Weight limit of 260 lbs. and minimum age of 5 yrs.**
- Personal Floatation Devices (provided by camp) must be worn aboard boats in the lake.
- **Completed waivers** must be submitted for all attendees.

Use of the Lodge and Pavilion

DO:

- Dispose of all trash in trash bins behind Lodge, or in bins at Pavilion.
- Wash out sink and clean counters of Pavilion. Remove all food and decorations upon leaving.
- Return all camp recreation equipment to its original location before leaving. Customer will be billed for equipment which is lost or damaged.
- Wipe clean each table and countertop used, even if covered with tablecloth. (For events *not* catered by Butter & Egg Adventures)
- **Park only in designated parking area, and ensure your guests do, as well.** Handicapped parking is located alongside the Lodge building and Pavilion.
- Complete clean-up and vacate facility by the ending time of your reservation.

DO NOT:

- Use confetti, small die-cut décor, or glitter for decorations.
- Enter any area which is not reserved for your event, such as lake, challenge course, zip line platforms, surrounding wooded areas, swimming pool, or Activity Center.
- Paint or glue (i.e., crafting, decorating) in Lodge or Pavilion.
- Use tobacco of any kind at camp. We are a Tobacco-Free facility.
- Consume alcoholic beverages on site.
- Play music outside the Lodge without prior permission. Pavilion music is subject to approval and must be kept at moderate level.
- Set up inflatable recreation (bounce houses, etc.) on property
- Bring guns, weapons, fireworks, skate or hoverboards, or (non-service) animals on site.

Miscellaneous

- Advise staff of special accommodations requested for disabled persons well in advance of event.
